Friendship Community Project (FCP) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to teaching English language and life skills to Iowa City area immigrants and refugees. More than 50% of our students are of low to moderate income.

We offer free English classes for adults and assist our students in accessing local resources, practicing conversation, and getting to know people in the community.



A Note From the Director

Dear friends,

This was our first full year of online-only activities due to the Coronavirus Pandemic. Although student numbers were down, at only 50 students for the year, we maintained active advanced, intermediate, and beginning classes during both spring and fall terms, in addition to two online conversation groups during the school year and two conversation groups, which sometimes met outdoors, plus a 6-week writing course for advanced students during the summer. For Fall, 2021, we plan mostly online classes with the exception of a small beginning class for those lacking the tech skills to access online classes. We plan to offer this group tech skills tutoring after class.

The pandemic necessitated other temporary changes: We have suspended participation in Community Conversation for reasons of logistics and low enrollment this year but plan to do so when the situation is right.

We have also put our partnership with the ICPD's Daisy Torres, who served as outreach officer to our program last year, on hold, but we have been in touch with her and plan to resume when in-person classes are possible. We participated in interviews related to the ICPD's minority outreach and minority recruitment efforts.

Our Computer Skills program, also temporarily suspended, will resume in Fall, 2021 in a different form with a small number of beginning students who will be meeting in-person. The Covid emergency has helped us prioritize cell phone skills over computer skills for beginning and other students who rely on phones rather than a computer for their online interactions. Skills will be taught to put them in a better position to access online classes and other programs and to receive community alerts related to but not limited to this current pandemic.

We converted our Friendship Pals program to a Phone Pals program during the Pandemic and had 22 students matched with 19 Phone Pals this year, as well as 5 tutors working online with a total of 7 students.

We have updated students on Covid-related resources and community resources via our email and Whatsap lists since March, and go word out warning of the Derecho 15 minutes before it hit. We also used these resources to let students know when we have a volunteer who would like to work with a student Phone Pal.

Our quarterly Hudson's Tap Community Night fundraisers continued via curbside pick-up, but in the summer, a few students ventured into the restaurant in person.
